

2010 NH Senior Games Competition Dates Set

Elizabeth Kuzia (Chair) GSSG (2010) pictured above, has announced this year's New Hampshire Granite State Senior Games, and the dates of over Sixteen Olympic Style Sports competition events for this year's Annual Summer Games which will begin with Women's (3 on 3) Basketball team competitions, to be held at the downtown YMCA gymnasium in Manchester, NH on July 17, 2010.

Stan Kuzia (Vice Chairman) pictured above right, of GSSG has confirmed that ALL remaining Senior Games Events (for 2010) will be held during the Month of August. "This year (2010) is going to be a big year for us ..." because it is a "qualifying year" for our "National Senior Games Association (NSGA) competitions" which will be held in Houston Texas in (2011).

The Granite State Senior Games (GSSG) remains today, as the only authorized NH nonprofit (501-c-3) volunteer organization which sponsors the NH Senior Games competitions for New Hampshire (50+ Seniors), held each year within the State of New Hampshire.

Senior athletes from New Hampshire, as well as from surrounding New England States, may become "qualifiers" for official entry into the National Senior Games (NSGA) competitions, which are held at various National Venues in the United States during all "Odd Years." Any athletes competing in the Granite State Senior Games during this "Even" year of competition who finish with a Gold, Silver, or Bronze Medal, or a fourth place Ribbon through their individual performances in the NH Senior Games, will become an automatic qualifier for the National Senior Games.

The NH Granite State Senior Games (GSSG), as a registered member of the National Senior Games Association (NSGA), is the only NH sports organization authorized to qualify competing Senior Athletes for the (NSGA) National Seniors Games Competitions to be held in Houston, Texas in 2011.

Athletes are being asked to register by early bird registration (after March 30, 2010) for their own selections of summer games in which they may wish to compete, in order to save dollars in costs for their Granite State Senior Games competitions.
