## Newly Elected Executive Board to lead NH Granite State Senior Games



The following board members of the NH Granite State Senior Games were elected at the GSSG November Meeting to the offices of President (2010 Chairperson), Vice-President (2010 Vice Chair), Secretary, and Treasurer of the Granite State Senior Games (the NH Senior Olympics) for one-year terms to run from November 2009, to December 2010.

The Granite State Senior Games (GSSG), is a Non Profit NH 501-C-3 Charitable organization which annually promotes "Healthy Living Pursuits in Seniors" (aged fifty and older) throughout the State of NH by each year, around the month of August, sponsoring a series of Olympic-Style sporting events, under the sponsorship of the GSSG which is more popularly known as the NH Granite State Senior Olympics.

The GSSG is the only authorized NH State Athletic organization, which is both sanctioned by the National Senior Games Association (NSGA) and authorized to qualify Senior Athletes from throughout the state of NH and surrounding New England States, to be able to compete (in even years), for National Senior Games held at pre-selected national sites during (the odd years) of (NSGA) National Senior Games Competition.

The "GSSG", sponsors sixteen different sporting events which include Track and Field, Swimming, Cycling, Bowling, Golf, Men's and Women's Basketball, Tennis, Table Tennis, Badminton, Archery, Pistol Shoot, Horseshoes, Shuffleboard and Racewalk which are available to all NH Seniors interested in competing for Gold, Silver, and Bronze medals which qualify them to represent the state of NH at the National Senior Games.
